



cake box cookie bars;

1. (kehrk bohx koo-kee bharz)
noun. Light and fluffy bars made from boxed cake mix and mixed with mini chocolate chips and mini m&ms.
2. Produces 12 Servings.
3. Preparation 35 mins.
4. Oven temperature set to 350.

Ingredients;

|----------------------------|----------------------------------|
| 1 15oz box white cake mix* | 5 oz vanilla instant pudding mix |
| ¼ c. water | ¾ c. vegetable oil |
| 2 eggs | ½ c. mini chocolate chips |
| ½ c. miniature m&ms | |

*alternatively, use yellow cake mix

Instructions,

1. In a bowl, combine cake mix, pudding, water, vegetable oil, and eggs and mix until combined.
2. Fold in chocolate chips and m&ms and mix until combined.
3. Line a 9"x13" pan with parchment paper and spray with cooking spray.
4. Spread batter into the pan and press into the corners using a spatula. Top with additional m&ms as desired.
5. Bake the bars for 20-30 minutes until edges are golden and beginning to crisp.
6. Remove from the oven and allow to cool for 15 minutes, then slice into bars and store in an airtight container for up to 2 weeks.
